Downtown Asheville offers nine

(and counting) hotel properties, an array of independent shops, craft breweries, and some of the best dining options in the southeast. Walkable and vibrant, downtown is also home to multiple conference and social event venues.

The U.S. Cellular Center,

downtown's largest multi-purpose event facility, is owned and operated by the City of Asheville. USCC has hosted thousands of events, including concerts, sporting events, trade shows, and corporate meetings and conventions. The facility completed a \$14 million dollar renovation in 2014.

The U.S. Cellular Center primarily consists of four venues:

- ExploreAsheville.com Arena with seating for 7,200
- + Thomas Wolfe Auditorium with seating for 2,431
- \pm Exhibit Hall with capacity for up to 2,000
- \star Banquet Hall with capacity for up to 500
- \pm 9 Meeting Rooms ranging from 336 to 2,408 sq ft
